The UCH-CEU summoned the Erasmus + Scholarships to promote student mobility for studies in the framework of the Erasmus +.

Application procedure

1. Attend briefings on Erasmus + scholarships in different centers of the University:

18.10 at 10:00h	Campus Elche - Aula Magna

19.10 at 16:00h	ESET- Salón de Actos.
20.10 at 13:30h	Campus Castellón - Salón de Actos

2. Register for language exam on your intranet and choose the language of your host university, one time for each language if you would like to choose different destinations.

Registration deadlines for the test: from 18th of October 2016, 09: 00h until **02nd of November 2016, 14: 00h.**

Registration deadlines incidence resolution: from **02nd of November 2016, 09: 00h until 04th of November 2016, 14: 00h**

IMPORTANT:

- **ALL** the applicants must register, including those who already have an official title, which has to be handed in the Language Service of the University until **02nd of November 2016, 14: 00h.**

- **In case of international students**, if the official language of their country of origin matches the language of Erasmus+ destination language, they don't need not take the exam, but have to register anyway and show their passport in the Language Service of the University until **02nd of November 2016 14:00h.**

- Students who are not registered **will have no access** to the test and therefore will not be eligible for the scholarship.

- **There is only one call for language exams.**

3. After obtaining the final results of the language tests, you will enable access to the selection of destinations.
